

Directive of the Rector of the Medical University of Lodz no 24/2020 of 17 March 2020

on the implementation of study programs using distance learning methods and techniques in connection with counteracting of the SARS-COV-2 virus spread among members of the community of the Medical University of Lodz

Based on Article 50 par. 1 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, it. 85, as amended), § 12 it. 3 and § 13 it. 2 of the Statute of the Medical University of Lodz of June 27, 2019, as amended, in connection with the entry into force of the Act of 2 March 2020 on special solutions related to the prevention, counteraction and eradication of COVID-19, of other infectious diseases and infection-related crisis situations (Journal of Laws, it. 374) and in connection with the Directive No. 20/2020 of 10 March 2020 of the Rector of the Medical University of Lodz on preventing the spread of the SARS-COV-2 virus among members of the Medical University community in Łódź, as amended (i.e. the Directive No. 22/2020 of 11 March 2020 of the Rector of the Medical University of Lodz), I am ordering the following:

§ 1

1. In order to limit the effects of temporary suspension of classes, introduced by the Directive No. 20/2020 of 10 March 2020, of the Rector of the Medical University of Lodz on preventing the spread of SARS-COV-2 virus among members of the community of the Medical University of Lodz, the obligation to implement study programs using distance learning methods and techniques is introduced at the Medical University of Lodz, hereinafter referred to as "the University".
2. In order to maximize the effects of distance learning, academic teachers and students are required to regularly check all University communication channels, including e-mail, intranet, Virtual University, University website and social media.
3. In connection with the implementation of classes in the form of online seminars - the so-called "Webinars", both teachers and students must be ready to take classes in real time (synchronous communication).

§ 2

1. The University is introducing tools to replace traditional teaching with classes conducted using distance learning methods and techniques, even if such method of conducting classes was not provided for in the study program.
2. In connection with § 4 of the Rector's Directive No. 20/2020 of 10 March 2020, the University shall immediately prepare organizational and infrastructure solutions to enable the widest possible implementation of study programs using distance learning methods and techniques.

§ 3

The solutions referred to in § 2 it. 2, enabling distance learning and providing didactic materials in electronic form, necessary to credit the course, accepted and supported by the University, are:

1. sending didactic materials to representatives of individual years of studies by e-mail - the list of representatives 's e-mail addresses is attached as Annex 1 to this Directive and is available at the Virtual University, in the "contacts to representatives" tab;
2. uploading teaching materials in the Virtual University system by course coordinators, in accordance with Annex 2 to this Directive; heads of research and teaching units are required to mobilize coordinators to assign classes at the Virtual University to academic teachers conducting them in order to enable assistants to add teaching materials and to place announcements improving communication with students;

3. conducting distance classes using Microsoft Teams tool available to all students and employees, as part of the Office 365 - this software supports group work by providing workspace that allows the transfer of teaching materials in digital form and the interaction between students and the teacher via video conference;
4. improving communication between teachers and individual groups of students by creating emailing groups for individual fields of study and years, whose name will be in accordance with the following scheme: faculty-field-type-year-academic year, e.g. FM-medicine-JMS-V year-2019_2020;
5. conducting distance classes in the form of a webinar using the Big Blue Button system and access to the "PRACTICUM UNIVERSITIES" International Clinical Application Teaching Platform and to the e-learning module containing a set of exam questions preparing for the LEK exam - training for teachers in this area will be provided by the Center Medical Education of the Medical University;
6. conducting classes using a course located on the University's e-learning test platform, available at: <https://e-learning2.umed.pl>, to which you must log in using your full e-mail address (firstname.lastname@umed.lodz.pl) and the account access password; in case of login problems, it is possible to get help at the following e-mail address: moodle@umed.pl; a help course was also launched at: <https://e-learning2.umed.pl/course/view.php?id=2730>.

§ 4
